### **SCHEDULING YOUR AUDITION**

We are taking actor sign-ups with priority given to members of AEA or SAG-AFTRA. We will reserve up to six (6) non-union actors each hour to fill slots around union members.

**NON-UNION ACTORS:** Please use this <u>LINK</u> to reserve a spot within a half-hour time block. You will receive an automated reminder 24 hours before your audition.

**AEA OR SAG-AFTRA MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING:** Please email <u>zenaidas@artswest.org</u> with "25-26 Season EPA" in the subject line to schedule an appointment on Monday 7/14 or Tuesday 7/15, 9:30 AM – 5:30 PM. Please include your preference for date and time of day.

Auditions will be attended by Artistic Director Mathew Wright and Production Manager Zenaida Smith. **Prepare for the following in your audition:** 

- A brief conversation. Tell us a little about yourself. What questions do you have about ArtsWest or the season?
- A monologue to share with us. Please keep your selection under two minutes in length.
- A headshot and resume are not required for an appointment. However, if you do have these items,

  the subject line.

#### **CONTRACT AND SCHEDULE DETAILS**

- Our rehearsal schedules vary based on the artists in each production; however, they are often weekday evenings and weekends, typically 22-30 hours per week prior to technical rehearsals.
- Technical rehearsals are typically 8 out of 9.5-hour days, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. We also have afternoon rehearsals before Invited Dress, Preview, and Opening performances.
- Our performance schedule is typically Thursday-Saturday at 7:30 PM and Sundays at 3:00 PM. *Penelope* will have two Saturday matinees as well.
- Callbacks for each production will be held throughout the summer of 2025.
- AEA Contracts are offered at \$705.84 per week. Non-Union contracts offer an hourly rate of \$21.00 for all hours called.
